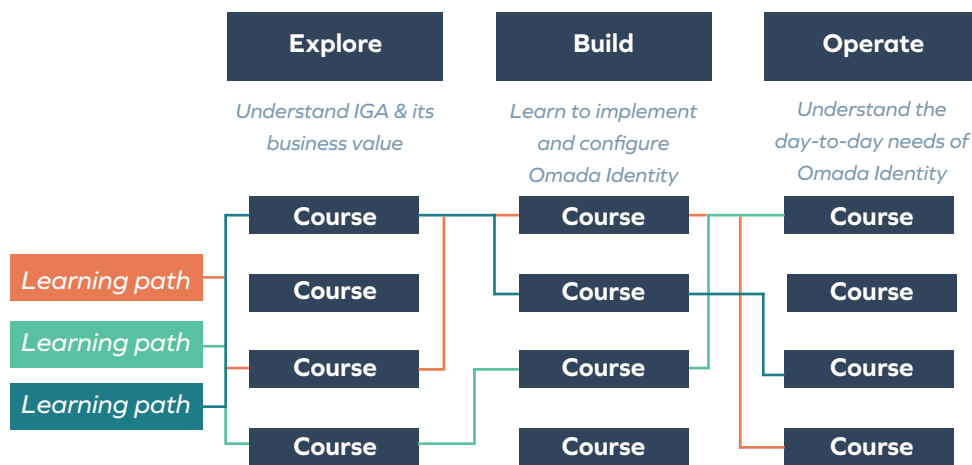


Introduction

The purpose of this document is to describe the available Omada training offerings, Omada Certification Program, and Omada’s knowledge sharing and learning portal called the Omada Hub. All these are made available to Omada customers and partners through Omada Academy.

Types of trainings

Omada Academy provides individual courses to allow participants dive into a specific topic or area, as well as several unique learning paths that bundle courses into role-based training programs for the most comprehensive and professionally directed skillset available. All our courses are organized into three different themes with specific learning paths:



Omada has the following types of training available*:

- **Instructor led Online Training** – Online on Microsoft Teams.
- **Self-paced digital training** – On Omada Hub.
- **Instructor led Training** – At a customer/partner location.

*At all our courses, the participants will receive training materials in English and get access to Omada Hub.

Duration

3 days.



Description

This learning path provides the participants with the skillset needed to become the organization's Super User, the Omada Identity Application Owner or Operations Manager.

The learning path introduces the participants to the general field of IGA as well as how Omada Identity works, and how it is installed and configured. It will also cover the concepts, principles and governance practices of Omada Identity application management, and address some of the more technical aspects of day-to-day operations including monitoring basic access troubleshooting.

Who should join?

Project Managers who are looking to deliver Omada Identity projects.



Prerequisites

Previous experience within managing and delivering projects.



Duration

2 days.



Description

This learning path provides the participants with the skillset needed to deliver Omada Identity projects, both standard and Accelerator Package.

The learning path introduces the participants to the general field of IGA and explains the best approaches and practices used to manage implementing Omada projects. It will also cover the Process+ and Project+ concepts and show examples of previous implementations.

FND100: Omada Identity Foundation



Who should join?

Everyone who must understand the basics of IGA and Omada Identity.



Prerequisites

The participants must complete the 35 minutes IGA Awareness self-paced digital training at Omada Hub. The participant will get access to this training when signing up for the FND100: Omada Identity Foundation course. Furthermore, a basic understanding of Microsoft components such as registry and file share and SQL experience can be an advantage.



Duration

6 hours self-paced digital training.



Description

This entry-level course is the starting point for everyone working with Omada Identity, outlining the process framework – IdentityPROCESS+ – that underpins the methodology and design.



Learning objectives

After completion, participants will:

- Understand the Identity and Access Governance area and the terminology.
- Understand how Omada Identity is used and configured.
- Understand the underlying architecture in order to understand the data flows between Omada Identity and target systems.
- Have a good understanding of how business processes are enabled by Omada Identity.
- How to do light configuration of these, based on a client's unique preferences.

IST100: IGA Sponsor Training



Who should join?

CISOs, Security Managers, IT Directors, and other IT professionals interested in understanding what business value an IGA solution brings a company and how to estimate the return on investment (ROI).



Prerequisites

No prerequisites.



Duration

1 day.



Description

Based on Omada's best practice framework, this course introduces participants to how to successfully scope and deploy an IGA solution to realize the security, compliance and efficiency benefits they need to run their business.

- Be able to deliver a project using Omada best practices and recommended tools.
- Be familiar with the Omada Project Manager profile.

ADT100: Omada Identity Accelerator Project Delivery



Who should join?

Project Managers having a perspective of delivering an Accelerator Package Project.



Prerequisites

- Previous PM experience.
- Understanding of Project+ and Process+.
- Familiarity with the AD connector guide.
- Completion of FND100: Omada Identity Foundation training.



Duration

2 hours.



Description

Participants will explore three phases of implementing an Accelerator Package: Initiation, Management and Conclusion. Each phase will contain description of tools, approaches, and best practices. The self-paced digital training will be followed up by an implementation case study.



Learning objectives

After completion, participants will:

- Understand the concept of the Accelerator Package.
- Be able to decide when extension or scope should be added to the accelerator package.
- Be able to deliver an Accelerator project using Omada best practices and recommended tools.

CFG200: Advanced Installation Training

This course will be provided as blended learning as a combination of self-paced digital training on Omada Hub and instructor led online training. You must complete the self-paced digital training before participating at the instructor led online training.

Everyone who wants advanced skills within the installation of Omada Identity components and recognizing the environmental pre-requisites for Omada product to work properly.



Prerequisites

Before starting this course, you should have completed the FND100: Omada Identity Foundation training. Participants should also have a good understanding of Windows Server features (IIS, Event Viewer), networking, SQL, SSIS & SSRS.



Duration

2 days.



Description

This course gives participants advanced knowledge about installation process of Omada Identity product along with environmental requirements that needs to be met before starting the installation process. After installation, a post-install configuration is done for confirming proper work of the solution for a next phase of the project.



Learning objectives

After completion, participants will:

- Understand the Omada requirements in the matter of server features and software.
- Understand the network relations between Omada product components.
- Be able to install Omada Identity on a newly created server(s).
- Implement post installation configuration for a Lights-On project phase.

APP200: Omada Identity Application Onboarding



Who should join?

Consultants and Solution Architects who work with Omada Identity implementations.



Prerequisites

No prerequisites.



Duration

1 hour.



Description

The aim of the Omada Identity Application Onboarding training is to make sure that all Consultants and Solution Architects are familiar with the standard procedure of onboarding applications and work accordingly.



Learning objectives

After completion, participants will:

- Define what an Application Onboarding is (contrary to a system onboarding).
- Explain why we do Application Onboarding.
- Explain the terms and concepts of the Application Onboarding.
- Perform an Application Onboarding consisting of the 3 steps:
 - Create application.
 - Create application account.
 - Onboard application.

CFG210: Omada Identity Workflows Configuration



Who should join?

Everyone who needs to understand the basics of how to configure the process and survey modules of Omada Identity to match businesses processes.



Prerequisites

Before starting this course, you must have completed the FND100: Omada Identity Foundation training.



Duration

5 hours self-paced digital training.



Description

This course gives participants an introduction to the rationale and framework for working with processes in Omada Identity and how this is configured to match a customer's business processes.



Learning objectives

After completion, participants will:

- Be able to build an Omada Identity workflow/process.
- Know how to initiate, control, close and follow-up on a survey.
- Understand, on an intermediate level, the creation of survey templates in Omada Identity.

TCA300: Omada Identity Cloud Training



Who should join?

Implementation Consultants, Solution Architects, Project Managers, and others looking to get a deep understanding and experience of an Omada Identity implementation.



Prerequisites

To participate in this training, participants should:

- Complete the 5 hours FND100: Omada Identity self-paced digital Foundation training.

Duration

10 days.



Description

The TCA300: Omada Identity Cloud Training Camp is based on a problem-solving approach where the participants will work in small project teams to deploy Omada Identity Cloud standards in a simulated real-life customer project.

The TCA300: Omada Identity Cloud Training Camp will be provided in a blended learning setup with a combination of instructor-led online training, digital self-paced training, and hands-on work in project teams.

Description of the 10 days of training

Guided by Omada experts, the teams will work on a real-life implementation project in which they go through a deployment of Omada Identity Cloud standards. During the implementation, the participants are faced with a couple of errors and setbacks, which they are expected to troubleshoot and solve on their own as a team.

This approach allows participants to take control of their learning and solve real-world problems using Omada Identity Cloud and, consequently, serves as preparation of field reality for the participants.

Learning objectives

- Deploy Omada Identity Cloud standards:
 - Collect Identity Data.
 - Collect Access Data.
 - Configuring processes and identities.
 - Conducting provisioning.

Duration

3 hours self-paced digital training and 1-day instructor led online training.



Description

This course gives participants advanced knowledge about the ODW component of the Omada Identity, including advanced loading of data and how to exchange data with the Enterprise Server component.



Learning objectives

After completion, participants will:

- Understand how data flows in Omada Identity.
- Have comprehensive knowledge of system onboarding – how to match data inside and outside of solution.
- Be able to build custom reports.

CON300: Omada Identity Connectivity



Who should join?

Everyone who wants to understand how Omada Identity connects with external systems and configure such connection.



Prerequisites

Before starting this course, the participant must have completed the FND100: Omada Identity Foundation training.

Participants should have a good understanding of LDAP, Active Directory, SAP, REST, networking, SQL.



Duration

5 hours self-paced digital training.



Description

This course gives participants advanced knowledge about connectivity of Omada Identity product. It takes them through basics of the data flow between the systems, and the whole process of configuring the connection with several external systems, including data import and provisioning, and choosing proper connectors and collectors.



Learning objectives

After completion, participants will:

- Understand the concepts and flow of data collection and data provisioning in Omada Identity.
- Be able to import data from company HR system.
- Understand how to use Omada Identity connectors.
- Be able to connect Active Directory to the solution.
- Know the basics of application onboarding.
- Be able to use Omada REST connectivity as a foundation to create a custom connector.

ROP300: Omada Identity Access Reconciliation

- Verify and troubleshoot the performance of various interfaces on the Omada Identity.
