Who Omada Identity Cloud Private Is Built For

Cloud-native IGA delivers faster deployment, continuous innovation, and lower operational overhead than on-premises alternatives. For most organizations, Omada Identity Cloud provides all of that through a fully managed, multi-tenant SaaS model. But for a growing number of enterprises, multi-tenant SaaS may not be an option because of what auditors and regulators require. Procurement and risk teams may expect clear answers on where identity data resides, who can access it, and how retention and deletion are enforced.

Omada Identity Cloud Private is built for three types of organizations:

Regulated enterprises and government organizations in banking, insurance, healthcare, critical infrastructure, public sector, defense, and industrial manufacturing where compliance mandates or internal policies prohibit shared cloud environments. For these organizations, tenant ownership provides the audit narrative and governance control that vendor-hosted alternatives cannot.

Organizations running legacy on-premises IGA platforms that need to modernize without surrendering data control or tenant isolation. Omada Identity Cloud Private provides a path to cloud-native IGA while keeping all data and platform resources within your own environment.

Managed-service partners looking to operate a customer's tenant-layer environment on their behalf. Partners handle infrastructure and tenant operations including upgrade execution; Omada provides the platform, software releases, and support, creating a scalable and repeatable delivery model for regulated verticals.

The complete Omada Identity Cloud application runs within your Azure tenant, in the region you select, placing all data, identity records, and platform resources within your cloud boundary.

You or your partner are responsible for the Azure environment itself, including infrastructure, networking, security posture, and operational processes such as monitoring, backup, disaster recovery, and upgrade execution. Omada provides the application software, release packages, deployment guidance, product support, and architectural best practices.
